Q2: CNL Safety Incident:

a. Effective approach: Yes: 28 No: 3

b. How to address more effectively – 22 comments.

* feedback highlighted contractors should be involved in presentation;

* discrepancy between CNL presentation and contractor's account.

* Contractors need to be informed when incident involving their company is to be discussed.

Note: results indicate more feedback would be useful. Question included in November SSF mini-survey.



August SSF Mini-Survey Results

Q3. Most interest/importance – Top 4 choices were:

- * Contractor Management – 9 responses;
- * NRU Bolt Incident – 6 responses;
- * OSH - 4 responses;
- * All - 3 responses.

Comments: 19 comments received. No clear trend. Being considered.
