



## Chimney Swift Count at NPD - You're Invited!

Did you know that the ventilation stack at CNL's NPD site is home to one of the largest roosts for a Species at Risk in Canada – the Chimney Swift. To preserve this habitat, the NPD Closure Project has decided to keep the stack as part of its decommissioning plan.

Since 2010, CNL has voluntarily participated in the National Roost Monitoring Program by conducting evening counts in the spring to help us monitor and understand Chimney Swift spring migration in Canada ... and you're invited to attend!

### NPD Chimney Swift Count Dates

- Wednesday, May 22
- Thursday, May 30
- Sunday, May 26
- Monday, June 3

*No registration required. Please arrive by 8:15 p.m. We ask that you refrain from taking pictures, wear long-pants and flat-soled shoes, and consider bringing bug repellent.*

### Directions to NPD (From Deep River)

- The site is located on Highway 17 between Deep River and Rolphton on the right-hand side of the road, about one kilometre past Cutler Lane and 16 kilometres from the traffic lights in Deep River
- The 911 number is 36510 and there is a CNL sign on the entrance gate
