

CNL – Call for Proposals – Call Release

Canadian Nuclear Laboratories (CNL) is announcing a Call for Proposals for Basic Research, Applied Research and Experimental Development projects.

The purpose of the Call for Proposals is intended to advance CNL's Science and Technology Priorities through collaborative research. Collaborations acceptable in this Call are to be organized via a university, federal government laboratory or institute, or any combination thereof, who act as the primary contact organization (proponent). A third-party participant, namely small- and medium-sized enterprises or non-federal institutions (such as provincial organizations and non-profit research institutions) acting as the secondary proponent or a Funding partner, would be considered favourably.

The process for proposal submission and selection will be conducted as follows:

- Preliminary Proposals to be submitted by 2015 November 27.
- Detailed Proposals from selected proponents to be submitted by 2015 December 21.
- Detailed Proposals reviewed and evaluated, and collaborations offered by 2016 January 29.
